Frequently Asked Questions

***How do I know if we are having an NTI Day?**

NTI days will be announced via One Call, Facebook, and local news outlets.

***How does my child know what assignments to complete on NTI days?**

NTI folders will be sent home with students on January 4, 2017.

Students will have assignments for 5 NTI days in the folder.

Assignments for days 6-10 will be sent home at a later time.

***What happens on an NTI Day?**

A NTI day is just like a regular school day. Students will complete the work for that particular NTI day (found in their NTI folder or online) and return the work to school the next day school is in session.

***What if my child loses his/her NTI packet?**
